The following information from the Registry of the International Court of Justice has been communicated to the Press :

The International Court will resume its hearing of the Corfu Channel Case at 10.30 a.m. on Monday, January 17th, 1949.

The Agent and Counsel of the United Kingdom Government will first be called on to make their oral Reply. The Agent and Counsel of the Albanian Government will then address the Court.

In its Order of December 17th, 1948, the Court had requested three naval officers : Commodore J. Bull, of the Royal Norwegian Navy, Commodore S. A. Forshell, of the Royal Swedish Navy, and Lieutenant-Commander S. J. W. Elfferich, of the Royal Netherlands Navy, to give an expert opinion on certain technical questions. The report of these experts was duly received by the Court within the time-limit which had been allowed them for that purpose and which expired to-day.
