

The following information from the Registry of the International Court of Justice has been communicated to the Press:

By an Order of August 19th, 1957, the President has fixed the date of expiry of the time-limits for the filing of the first two pleadings in the Case concerning the Guardianship of an infant, as follows:

- for the Memorial of the Netherlands Government, Saturday, November 30th, 1957;
- for the Counter-Memorial of the Swedish Government, Monday, March 31st, 1958.

The rest of the procedure has been reserved for further decision.

The Application instituting proceedings was filed in the Registry of the Court by the Netherlands Government on July 10th, 1957. The Parties having expressed the wish that the time-limits for the filing of the Memorial and Counter-Memorial should not be fixed before the middle of August, the President agreed to postpone the making of the Order. The dates which have just been fixed are those which the Parties proposed in agreement.
