Further to the Communiqués of 28 December 1961 (No. 61/21), 16 March 1962 (No. 62/6) and 17 April 1962 (No. 62/10) and in the matter of Financial obligations of Members of the United Nations (Article 17, paragraph 2, of the Charter) submitted to the Court by the General Assembly of the United Nations with a request for an Advisory Opinion, the Registry of the Court has to date received the following information concerning the States which will participate in the oral proceedings:
