Request for Advisory Opinion on the Legal Consequences for
States of the Continued Presence of South Africa in
Namibia (South West Africa) notwithstanding Security
Council Resolution 276 (1970)

The following information is communicated to the Press by the
Registry of the International Court of Justice:

On 26 January 1971 the Court made three Orders whereby it decided
not to accede to the objections raised by the Government of South
Africa, in its written statement filed on 19 November 1970, against
the participation of President Sir Muhammad Zafrulla Khan,
Judge Padilla Nervo and Judge Morozov in the proceedings concerning
the above-mentioned request for an advisory opinion.
